

Citing Audiovisual Media

1. Chicago Manual of Style

(*Chicago Manual of Style*. 17th edition. Chicago: University of Chicago Press, 2017.)

(Here the “author-date” in text + bibliography format is used; of course, you can also use the variant “footnotes / endnotes” + bibliography for audiovisual media).

Standard citation form

Artist or Performer Last name, First name. Year. *Title: Subtitle*. Recording location: Publisher, recording date and month.

Standard citation form for YouTube / Vimeo Videos

Author Last name, First name. OR Artist name. Year. “Video Title.” YouTube OR Vimeo Video, Video length, Recording date and month. URL.

Blog comments are not included in the bibliography; they should only be referenced in the body text in relation to the original blog entry:

In a comment on Ahmed (2015) on *Feminist Killjoys* (dated April 12, 2016), Stacie A. Swain agrees with the blog author's April 10, 2016 statement.

E-Mail message

Since e-mails are usually not publicly accessible, CMS recommends referencing them only in brackets in the text, but not in the bibliography. The text insert looks like this:

(Nina Hoss, e-mail to author, July 15, 2016).

Standard citation form for all forms of media:

Author. Title. Title of the parent work, Edition, Season, Episode, Publisher, Publication date, Location.
